Why don't you come and discover the hidden charm of Ueno area? UENO PARK, which hosts a number of Japan's top museums, is a crossroad of Japanese incomparable culture and history. The area was originally a Tokugawa shogun's family temple, and later became a battlefield of the civil war in the mid-19th century, which led Japan to the Meiji era of westernization.

Through this tour, you can enjoy traces of the Edo Shogun era, the civil war, and the Meiji era, realizing the incredible size of the world's largest animal.

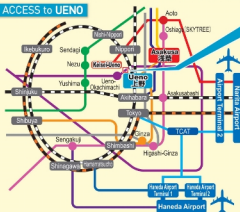
