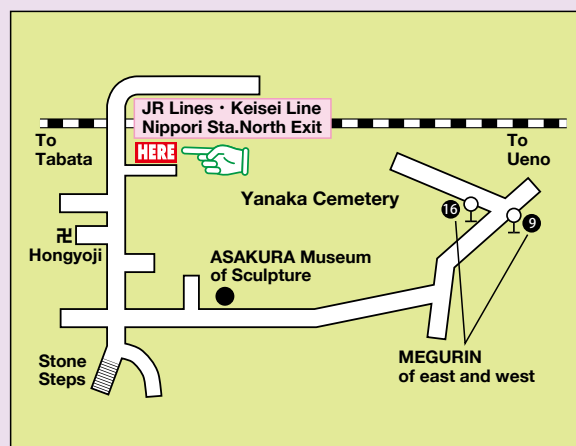


ASAKURA Museum of Sculpture

ASAKURA Museum of Sculpture was once a studio and residence of ASAKURA Fumio (1883-1964), a leading sculptor of modern Japan. ASAKURA designed and supervised the construction of the building himself, completing it in 1935. Today, the building is open to the public as an art museum exhibiting ASAKURA's collection of masterpieces, including *Grave keeper*.
